MP3 is a widely-used audio format for audio streaming and storage. With it, you can transfer and play music on almost most of the digital audio players. This post will offer your specific guidance on how to transfer MP3 audio files from your computer to your iPhone or android device.

Apple / iPhones

- 1. First download the audio file to your computer.
- 2. Getting an audio file onto your Apple iPhone takes a few steps. We recommend following the instructions at the following link:

Android Devices

- 1. First download the audio file to your computer.
- 2. Connect your computer to your device using a USB cable.
 - a. If you are prompted on your phone to select a USB connection, select "Media device (MTP)" (this allows file transfers between your phone and your computer).

Open one window on your computer that contains the audio file(s) you want to transfer.

Open another window that is the location of your audio files on your phone (usually a folder like "Music").

Simply drag and drop the audio file(s) from the location on your computer into the folder on your phone.

Now you should be able to open your Music player app on your android phone, find the audio file in there (search, or sort by folder/artist) and tap the track(s) you want to play.
